INTRODUCTION TO THE SUBSIDIARY LEGISLATION

There are 12 pieces of subsidiary legislation to the Companies Ordinance, including two amendment regulations. They deal with the administrative, procedural and technical details of the Companies Ordinance. Fourteen of these were gazette on various dates but all of them came into force on 3 March 2014, the same date as the new Companies Ordinance (Cap. 622) came into effect. The subsidiary legislation have been designated Cap 622A to Cap 622L.

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
